**Reflection**

The 16 personalities test while isn't a true Myers-Briggs test does utilize the original 16 personality archetypes that Myers-Briggs used. It is important to remember that Myers-Briggs revolved their work heavily around Carl Jung's work on personality. Therefore, any variation from Myers-Briggs should be analyzed with heavy scrutiny. Especially when the website considers characters like Gandalf to be an Architect and River Tam to be a Commander when they were betrayed by someone their whole plan focused around and suffer from debilitating mental torture making them shutdown, respectively. In this case, I don't believe the exam accurately depicted my personality stating I was an INFJ (Advocate). While some of the strengths are flattering some of them just don't match up to me such as a popular charm that makes people drawn towards me. Or that perfectionism is one of my weaknesses which leads me to avoid unhealthy relationships which I wish was the case for me. What I do believe was correct about was that I do have a penchant for egalitarianism and I'd like to believe that I'm as creative as the test makes me out to be. But I believe the biggest miscalculation is my turbulence and assertiveness. I'd like to think I'm more assertive especially when I know I'm in the right. I'd

rarely think of myself as turbulent unless I'm in a clear position of less power than the other person but even then I have instances where I still stand for what I know is right.

**Reflection**

To supplement my finding I went to another test provider to further investigate my personality.

The personality test that I took gave me the top 3 matching personality types which are ENTP (Inventor), INTP (Architect), and ENFP (Champion). Just from averaging out these personality types you can tell that my personality leans heavily towards Perception and Intuition as opposed to Judging and Sensing, respectively. As for Extraversion and Thinking, I only slightly lean towards those ends of the spectrum as opposed to their counterparts Introversion and Sensing. A deeper look at the percentages shows just exactly how accurate these results are. As stated before, Perception and Intuition are the two highest rates scores. However, Intuition outscored Perception by 16 percentage points. In summary the test says that; I enjoy working with other people while still being able to appreciate the alone time, can adapt be very adaptive even though I have clear expectations, have a heavy emphasis on innovation and creativity while respecting the reality of a situation, and while I appreciate the value of empathy I prefer to be grounded in logic and reason. I can say with certainty that these results are accurate as these qualities really do reflect how I feel about myself.
