- STEPS FOR COLLEGE REGISTRATION -

- _____ **1. Complete application for admission to the college, university, or school of your choice.**
- _____ **2. Apply for financial aid:**
 - o Create FSA ID
 - o Submit FAFSA
 - o Local scholarships: _____
- _____ **3. Check your email!** In the next 3-5 business days, your college or university will notify you that your application for admission and FAFSA were received, and any additional requirements.
- _____ **4. Provide your official high school transcript or GED certificate to the admissions office.**
You can obtain an official high school transcript from the counselor at your high school, or you may also request a copy from the following link:

- _____ **5. Provide your official transcript from each college or university you have previously attended to the admissions office.** You can obtain your official college transcript from the Registrar or Records office at your previous college or university. [This includes dual credit!](#)
- _____ **6. If you are under the age of 22, you will need to provide verification that you have received a bacterial meningitis vaccine within the last five years.**
[You may obtain the vaccine through your doctor's office, local pharmacies, or the Texas Department of Health: 108 E. Kilpatrick, Cleburne, TX 76031, Phone: 817-517-2306](#)
- _____ **7. Once you have your acceptance email/letter, it's time to contact the office of academic advising at your school of choice for the next step in registering for your courses.**
- _____ **8. You may be required to take the TSI assessment.** If you are enrolling for a degree program, you may have to take placement testing in reading, writing, and math. If you are pursuing a certificate, in most cases you will be exempt from the TSI.
- _____ **9. Log in to your financial aid portal and accept or deny your financial aid award.**
Accept your PELL Grant, if eligible, and accept, modify, or decline any loan offers.
